SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. This Local Law shall be known and may be cited as the Town of Clarendon Parks Law.

SECTION 2. SCOPE. The prohibitions, rules and regulations contained in this Local Law shall apply to all parks and public lands and facilities devoted or used for recreational or similar purposes owned, leased or otherwise under the control, supervision and jurisdiction of the Town of Clarendon, Orleans County, New York.

SECTION 3. HOURS. No Person shall be or remain within any town park between the hours of 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM prevailing local time in the Town of Clarendon, Orleans County, New York.

SECTION 4. SIGNS & ADVERTISING. No person shall post or display any sign, banner or advertisement of any kind within any park in the Town of Clarendon, Orleans County, New York.

SECTION 5. COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES. No person shall keep or offer any merchandise or articles for sale, nor shall any person solicit customers for services to be rendered by such person or another person; nor shall any person engage in any commercial or business activities within any park in the Town of Clarendon, Orleans County, New York.

SECTION 6. HORSES. No person shall have, ride or lead any horse or pony in any park in the Town of Clarendon, Orleans County, New York.

SECTION 7. FIRES. No person shall make, kindle or maintain any fire in any park in the Town of Clarendon except in fireplaces that may be provided in such parks or in a metal grill or burner used for food preparation.

SECTION 8. DEFACING PROPERTY. No person shall deface, write, paint or carve in or upon any tree, bench, building or structure of any kind or any other property located in any park in the Town of Clarendon, Orleans County, New York.

SECTION 9. FIREARMS & WEAPONS. No person shall possess, carry, fire or discharge any gun, pistol, firearm, rocket, torpedo or other fireworks of any description or any bow or arrow or other weapon in any park in the Town of Clarendon.

SECTION 10. EXCAVATIONS. No person shall dig or cause to be dug any excavations, holes or trenches in any park in the Town of Clarendon nor shall any person remove any top soil, earth or rocks from any park in the Town of Clarendon.

SECTION 11. PLANTS & VEGETATION. No person shall cut, dig up, pick or otherwise disturb or remove any flowers, bushes, shrubs or trees located in any park in the Town of Clarendon.

SECTION 12. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES. No person shall possess or consume any alcoholic beverages, including but not limited to wine or beer in any park in the Town of Clarendon.

SECTION 13. LITTERING. No person shall bring into, deposit, leave behind or dump or dispose of any refuse, ashes, garbage or other putrescible materials in any park in the Town of Clarendon except that garbage, ashes and other refuse resulting from picnic or other legal activities conducted in said park may be disposed of within said parks by depositing the same in refuse receptacles only.

SECTION 14. MOTOR VEHICLES. No person shall operate any vehicle, including but not limited to automobiles, motorcycles, snowmobiles, mini-bikes, all-terrain vehicles, dirt bikes or any other vehicle in any park in the Town of Clarendon except under the parking areas established and maintained in said parks. No vehicle of any description shall be or remain in the parking area or other areas of said park during the hours when said parks are closed as set forth in Section 3 of this local law.

SECTION 15. FURTHER REGULATIONS. The use of the parks within the Town of Clarendon shall be subject to further regulations from time to time adopted by resolution of the Town Board of the Town of Clarendon.

SECTION 16. PENALTIES. Any violation or any provisions of this Local Law shall constitute a violation pursuant to the Penal Law and any persons convicted of a violation of this Local Law shall be subject to a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty and no/100 (\$250.00) Dollars for each violation.

SECTION 17. SEPERABILITY. If any provision of this Local Law shall be judged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such judgement shall not effect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this local law which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 18. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.

According to the foregoing Local Law No. 1 of the Year 1981 establishing rules and regulations for the use and operation of Town Parks within the Town of Clarendon, Orleans County, New York, I hereby acknowledge my responsibilities in using the Town Park facilities and agree to pay for damage or clean-up if it is needed following my function / reservation. I also recognize that the Town of Clarendon is not liable for injuries of any kind.
